

ENTERING PENNSYLVANIA FROM ANY OTHER STATE

COVID-19 Information for Travelers

- The Secretary of Health issued an order requiring anyone who visits from another state to have a **negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to entering** the commonwealth.
- If someone cannot get a test or chooses not to, they must **quarantine for 14 days** upon arrival in Pennsylvania.
- Pennsylvanians visiting other states are required to have a **negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to their return** to the commonwealth, or to **quarantine for 14 days** upon return to Pennsylvania. This does NOT apply to people who commute to and from another state for work or medical treatment.
- This requirement applies to both out-of-state visitors to Pennsylvania and to Pennsylvanians coming back from a trip to another country or state.
- This order takes effect at 12:01 a.m. **Friday, November 20.**

WLE EFFORTS:

- In order to obtain a guest pass you must present documentation showing you have a negative COVID-19 test results within the past 3 days. If you cannot show proof, you will receive a red hang tag which does not allow you access to any of our amenities.
- This applies to Short Term rentals and all guests visiting WLE.

STRENGTHENED MASKING ORDER

Dr. Levine first issued a masking order on April 15. The [order signed today](#) strengthens this initial order with these inclusions:

- Masks are required to be worn indoors and outdoors if you are away from your home.
- When outdoors, a mask must be worn if you are not able to remain physically distant (at least 6 feet away) from someone not in your household the entire time you are outdoors.
- When indoors, masks will now be required even if you are physically distant from members not in your household. This means that even if you are able to be 6 feet apart, you will need to wear a mask while inside if with people other than members of your household.
- This order applies to every indoor facility, including homes, retail establishments, gyms, doctors' offices, public transportation, and anywhere food is prepared, packaged or served.
